

Unit VI Summative Infographic Project

Instead of multiple choice and essays, for this unit you will be putting all the pieces together and representing the Unit in picture form (with a little explanation in writing too!). **You may work with one partner or by yourself.** Please read through these instructions carefully.

30-point project in the test category

Using the key concepts provided, you will create an Infographic representation of Period 6: Key concepts 6.1, 6.2, & 6.3.

- *Each Key Concept has numerous sub concepts. You only need represent the overall concept in your project.*
- *The sub-concepts will help guide you through the overall concept.*

Requirements:

- Title that includes Period 6 and date range.
- Visual representations of Key Concept 6.1, 6.2, & 6.3 (3 total)
 - These can be a collage of different images that combine together to portray each Concept
 - There should be a clear separation between each concept
 - You will not be graded on artistic ability, but you should be able to tell what is going on in the pictures.
- Written description of image above describing how it encompasses the Key Concept.
 - These can be written on the back or incorporated into the overall design
- Must utilize the entire paper space.

Work will be divided into two days:

- Day 1: Planning
 - Plan out your drawing and the explanation for each picture (How does it relate to the key concept)
 - **You will not get your final infographic paper until the day of your exam!**
- Day 2: Creation
 - You will have about 1 hour to create your finished product in class.
 - Projects will be collected at the end of the class period on the day of your assessment.

Infographic Size: A little larger than a piece of printer paper.

Grading (30 points)

- Visual representation (0-10)
- Written description (0-15)
- Neatness and effort (0-5)
